Hexagonal Spell Templates — Revised by Zinovia

So after some consideration of advice received on ENWorld, I redesigned my spell templates so that they are more consistent in size with each other. In my initial design, I fixated too much on keeping the number of hexes in the spell the same in as the square version - but only for blasts, rather than bursts. My burst spell template is more or less the same, other than combining the different sizes into one template.

As for blast spells, I have since gone to a 60° cone shape and given up on the idea of aiming off the side of the hex rather than the point (the shapes get ugly and weird). There is a marked starting hex on the burst template that needs to be in any hex adjacent to the caster. Like the bursts, I combined them into a single template.

If printed on transparency film, you will need only 2 templates; one for blasts, and one for bursts. I don't have any fun pictures of the new version yet, but here's one of the old ones just for an idea of how they look in actual use. Enjoy, and send feedback to Zinovia on ENWorld or the WotC forums. Print them using transparency film designed for ink jet



printers, using whatever color settings work best for your printer. The text is reversed so that it will print on the rough side of the template and show through from the front.
